This book presents the long version. Part 1 of this book will give you a quick look at the journey that transformed my identity from being found in what I did to a product of who I am. If this book had a theme, this would be it – I had become so consumed by what I did that I became totally disconnected from who I was. In chapters 2-4 I will share with you three stories that culminated in what I would consider the fourth greatest defining moment of my life.

In Part 2 I will define four POSITIONS of leadership: leading thy self, leading at home, leading at work and leading at large. I will also explore the focus points that have helped me embrace those positions.

In Part 3 I will take you through the developmental progression of an influential leader. This is about the PERSON. I believe that all success begins within the individual. Any success related to a product or service is a direct result of the person or people providing or producing it. The progression is through Awareness, Environment, Growth, Communication, all leading up to Influence. Although these can be independent and certainly overlap, I believe that the stronger you become in one will provide greater success in the next.

In Part 4 I will share the RSVP process with you, the PLAN. The RSVP process, when followed, will provide clarity in the areas of

Results, Strategy, Vision and Purpose. Clarity in these four areas will provide knowledge and skills needed to become an influential leader in both your personal and professional life.

At some point in your life, you will be a parent, a spouse, or a co-worker. You will always be part of a family and a community. Whether or not you recognized them, every day you receive invitations to be a leader. My desire and intent in sharing this book with you is that it will equip and empower you to answer that invitation and become the leader you are meant to be.
